appurtenances thereto belonging likewise all my Land & marsh at the back bay to him & his heirs
for ever, always Excepting & reserving to my loving wife her full thirds according to Law of the said
plantation, & the liberty of making use of the whole during her widowhood only; not to be molested
or hindered by my said son, also of privilege of driving cattle to y said marsh during y time of
her continuall widow & no longer - It: I give & boguath to my son Anthony my Lot of Land
norfolk Town & two Islands called Mary Tong & Do to him & to his heirs for ever - It: I give and
devise unto my son Thomas walke my Land & houses in New Town my Tract of Land at head of
the havon river, & two Islands Phillip & Donick to him & his heirs for ever, also my said son Thomas -
all & Smiths Tools that belong to y Smiths Shop in New Town or that shall hereafter come from England
I give to my daughter Elizabeth walke two Islands called Tom & Nancy to her & her heirs for ever
to be delivered her when she comes to Sixteen years of age or marryed which may first happen - It: I
give to my daughter Katherine walke two Islands called mingo & venus to her & her heirs for ever to be
delivered her when she comes to y age of sixteen years or day of marriage which may first happen
I give to my loving wife fifty pounds for the bringing up & Educating my children - also all
my Stock of horses Cattle & sheep & hoggs, one bed & furniture her choice of all I have, & my two Islands
Hugh & Peggy to her & her heirs for ever - I order & appoint that my four Islands Tom, Betty, Scyco
& Robin be appraised with y rest of my Estate that shall not be otherwise disposed of, & the whole
after my just debts & funeral expences are abated to be Equally divided amongst & between my
wife & children to whom I give y Islands - my will & desire is that all my plate be Equally divided
between my wife & children or the survivor of them when my Eldest Son shall come of age which
plate I give to my said wife & children to be divided as aforesaid. - I Do hereby nominate & appoint
my Deare wife Katherine walke my loving brother Anthony walke to be Execrs of this my last

for ever, always Excepting & reserving to my loving wife her full thirds according to law of the said plantation, & the liberty of making use of the whole during her widowhood only; not to be molested or hindered by my said son, also of privilege of driving cattle to y^e said marsh during y^e time of her continuing a widow & no longer in it. I give & bequeath to my son Anthony my Lot of Land in norfolk Town & three Islands called Mary, Dingo & Goode to him & his heirs for ever — It. I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Walkers land & houses in New Town my Tract of Land at y^e head of Linhavon river, & two Islands Phillip & Donick to him & his heirs for ever, also my said son Thomas — all y^e Smiths Tools that belong to y^e Smiths Shop in New Town or that shall hereafter come from England — I give to my daughter Elizabeth Walkers two Islands called Tom & Harvey to her & her heirs for ever to be delivered her when she comes to sixteen years of age or marryed which may first happen. It. I give to my daughter Katherine Walkers two Islands called Mingo & Venus to her & her heirs for ever to be delivered her when she comes to y^e age of sixteen years or day of marriage which may first happen — I give to my tender loving wife fifty pounds for the bringing up & educating my children — also all my Stock of Horses Cattle Sheep & hogs, one bed & furniture her choice of all I have, & my two Slaves Hugh & Peggy to her & her heirs for ever — I order & appoint that my four Islands Tom, Betty Seip & Robin be appraised with y^e rest of my Estate that shall not be otherwise disposed of, & the whole after my just debts & funeral expences are abated to be equally divided amongst & between my wife & children or to whom I give y^e same, my will & desire is that all my plate be equally divided between my wife & children or the survivor of them when my eldest son shall come of age which plate I give to my said wife & children to be divided as aforesaid. — I do hereby nominate & appoint my dear wife Katherine Walker & my loving brother Anthony Walker to be Exes of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have heretounto set my hand & seal y^e 22nd Day of March
