Ashley's Exeutors hereafter named and as for what part of this world's goods it hath pleased god
will bless me with I dispose of as followeth viz ~ It is in my will & desire is that
my loving wife Mary Ashley should be with child that my negro boy called Comick
be sold and the money laid up for the child or if the child die before it arriveth
age then I give & bequeath the aforesaid negro called Comick to my loving sister Mrs
Bentley & her heirs for ever she living on the either side of North Carolina
called for me ~ Now I give & bequeath unto my dear loving wife Mary Ashley
all & singular g. goods chattels & remainder & residue of my Estate both
within doors & without moveable & immoveable that are not here before given or bequeathed
& I do hereby nominate & appoint and ordain my loving wife Mary Ashley my whole
Sols Executrix of this my last will & Testament who unto I have herunto set my hand
& fixed myself to this date and Day above mentioned
