Item I give and bequeath the Plantation whereon John Heeling now lives to Marian Heeling Wife of the said John Heeling to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to the said Marian Heeling my Marsh at the Salt Ponds to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath unto the said Marian Heeling my Swamp Land and my Part of Marsh at the Old Inlet to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath unto the said Marian Heeling One Negro Girl named Sarah to her and her heirs for ever and one Large Hote that was her Father's. Item I give and bequeath unto Betty Dale One Negro Girl named Judy to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath unto Rachel Dale four Negroes Luke Dinah Affrica Robin to her and her Children but if she should die without any Children then I give the said Negroes Between Betty Dale and Marian Heeling to them & their Heirs. Item I give and bequeath to my Sister Elizabeth Dale One Negro Man named Cesar and all the rest of my Estate that I have not already given to her and her heirs for ever. I do appoint my Sister Elizabeth Dale my whole & sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament. In Witness and firmation whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 19 Day of Decemr 1751

In the Name of God Amen I Robert Mason being in perfect Health &c I give and bequeath unto my Son James Mason all my Land and Plantation to him and his heirs for ever after his Mother's decease and one Mare to him and his heirs for ever and one Cow and heifer and one yearling to him and his heirs for ever and also I give my said Son James Mason one Bed and furniture to it and one Iron pot and a fewed Duck and one Set of Iron Wiegels to him and his heirs for ever and one Mile of one Cow and one peewee and all my Carpenter's Tools and one Saddle to him and his heirs for ever and all my Cyder Cask to my Son after his Mother's decease and one Chest after his Mother's Decease.
