 weak of body but of perfect mind & memory beologed for to make this my last will & testament in the
 manner & form following - I give & bequeath my soul to God that gave it in this and
 certain hope of a lively resurrection throu the merits of Jesus Christ my redemer &
 my body to be buryed at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named - first I will
 that all my lawful debts be truly contented & paid - Itm. I give & bequeath to Rich:
 Bonnoy my son the manner plantation wher on I now live containing about one
 hundred thirty three acres to him & his heirs for ever to Ditto. one of feather bed & furniture
 that he has in possession & one iron pot & what pewter he has in possession & one mare which
 he is posses with to him & his heirs I give to Ditto my son one hand mill to him & his heirs -
 It. I give & bequeath to William & John Bonnoy my sons all y: rest of my land which is
 about two hundred & sixty six acres to be equally divided between them only William to
 have his choice to them & their heirs for ever. - It. I give my son William Bonnoy four
 head of cattle his choice of my stock also one gray mare to him & his heirs. - It. I give &
 bequeath to John Bonnoy my son one bay mare & a long island if she be alive to him and
 his heirs: - It. I give & bequeath all my thospe hogs & corn & meat & what thread & yarn is
 spun to be divided between my two sons William & John Bonnoy. - It. I give to my son
 William Bonnoy one of feather bed & furniture & iron pot & postle & one chest to him and
 his heirs: - It. I give to John my son one of feather bed & furniture & one iron pot & postle
 & one chest to him & his heirs: - and as for the rest of my Estate I leave to be equally
 divided between my three sons appointing my sons Richard & William Bonnoy Joynt
 together my heirs & sole Exors of this my last will & Testament revoking & disanulling
 all other wills & Testaments by me formerly made in fidelity herof I have hereunto
 set my hand & seal the Day and year Above writt on

Princess Anne At Court hold y: 2 of May 1732
 Thon the within last will & Testament of
 William Bonnoy &c. was produced in Court by
 his Exors thersin named who read oath thereto
 and being proved by the oaths of Ursula Bonnoy &
 Elizabeth Henty wth no further it is admitted to Record
