In the Name of God Amen December the 26: day 1732 I William Bonney being sick in
weak of body but of perfect mind & memory doth make & ordain this my last will &
manner & form following: - I give & bequeath my soul to God that gave it in shorr and
certain hope of a lively resurrection thru the merits of Jesus Christ my redeemer &
my body to be buryed at the discretion of my Executors here after named - first I will
that all my Lawful debts be truly accounted & paid - It is I give & bequeath to them
Bonney my son the manner plantation wheron I now live containing about one
hundred thirty three acres to him & his heirs for ever to Ditt: one feather bed & furniture
that he having possession & one iron pot & what pewter he has in posession now or ever which
he is possesst with to him & his heirs I give to Ditt: my son on his hand mill taking his heirs -
It I give & bequeath to William & John Bonney my sons all y: rest of my lands which is
about two hundred & sixty six acres to be equally divided between them only William to
have his choice to them & his heirs for ever - It I give my son William Bonney four
hod of battle & his choice of my Stock also one gray mare to him & his heirs - It I give
bequeath to John Bonney my son one bay mare at Long Island if she bearing to him and
his heirs: - It I give & bequeath all my Sheep hogs & Corn meal & what bread & yarn is
his heirs: - It I give & bequeath all my Fish & eggs & Corn meal & what bread & yarn is
his heirs: - It I give to my son William Bonney & John Bonney - It I give to my son
Spun to be divided between my two sons William & John Bonney - It I give to my son
William Bonney one feather bed & furniture & Iron pot & pestle on her chest to him and
his heirs: - It I give to John my son one feather bed & furniture & Iron pot & pestle
& one chest to him & his heirs: - and as for the rest of my Estate I leave to be equally
divided between my three sons appointing my Son Richard & William Bonney to be
divided between my three sons appointing my Son Richard & William Bonney to be
together my hale & sole executors of this my last will & Testament according to disallowing
all other wills & Testaments by me formerly made in fidelity herof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal the Day and year above written
