 for a provile to go to them & their heirs: - Item I give to my sist
 five pound in cash & likewise four large new powder dishes &
 plates & one of flint: - God Iick & also one piece of Bow & one
 twenty yard of Ch. Linen twenty yard of Crombr: -
 William Barfoot two gins & fifty shoyards of Chex Linen: -
 one piece of duroy with buckram wading silk & a remnant of shalor
 I give & bequeath to Mary malbone wid: of Rood: malbone twenty y
 and eight yard of Cotton Chex & a remnant of holland Chex & one piece of slash & a likewi
 twenty pistoles: - Item I give to Floratio woodhouse Eleven & a quarter yards of fine holar
 I give to Abia Cox & her heirs two & a half acres of land lying at the mouth of Lin haven river
 be y James more or less: - Item all rest of my Estate either personal or all I give to my broth
 and sister Samuel & Sarah Brock & their heirs for Ever: and I do hereby nominate appoi
 & ordain my brother in law Samuel Brock my whole & sole Executor of this my last will
 and Testament but I do also appoint my good friend Jacob Ellegood to oversee
 that this my will be executed & performed accordingly In witness whereof I do hereunto
 set my hand and seal this 21. Day of April 1728
