Cason and Samuel Tenant are held and firmly bound to our Sovereign Lord the King his heirs and successors in the sum of Fifty pounds current money of Virginia to the which payments well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs and successors firmly by these presents sealed with our seal and dated this 18th day of February 1762. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above William Cason hath obtained...unreadable...in conjunction with Miss Mary Smith now known ye that if there is no lawful cause to obstruct the said Marriage then the above obligation to be void and otherwise to be in full force & virtue. Executed by William Cason and Samuel Tenant. Signed and sealed in Presence Robert Ballard.
