This Indenture made the fourteenth day of April in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty four Between Anthony Whitchurch of the County of Prince Anne of the one part and James Hunter of the same County other Part witnesseth That the said Anthony Whitchurch for and in Consideration of the sum of five Shillings current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said James Hunter at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted Bargained sold and by these presents take grant bargained and sold unto the said James Hunter all that tract of Plantation of Land of his containing fifty acres more or less situate in the Western Shore precincts in the Parish of Lynnhaven of County of Prince Anne after joining on the Lands of Thomas Buine Thomas Thelabate deceased Christopher Moseley and the said James Hunter and all Houses Buildings orchards ways Waters Water Courses Profits Commodities Hereditaments and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises hereby granted or any part thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining And the reversion and Reversionary Remainder and Remainderments Issues and Profits thereof to have and to hold to the said tract and plantation of land and all and singular that the premises hereby granted with the Appurtenances unto the said James Hunter his Executors Administrators and Assigns from the Day before the Date hereof for and during the full Term and Time of one Whole Year from whence next ensuing fully to be compleat and ended Saking and paying therefore the rent of one Pepper Corn on Lady Day next if the same shall be lawfully demanded to the intent and purpose that by virtue of these presents and of the Statute for Transferring these into possession the said James Hunter may be in actual possession of the premises and be thereby enabled to accept and take a Grant and release of the Reversion and inheritance thereof to him and his Heirs In Witness whereof the said Anthony Whitchurch hath

& thereof doth release acquit and discharge the said James Hunter his heirs and assigns  
by these presents he the said Anthony Whitehurst hath granted bargained sold alienated  
Released and Conformed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alienate release  
and Conform unto the said James Hunter (in his actual possession now being by virtue  
of a Bargain and Sale to him thereof made by the said Antho Whitehurst for one whole  
year by Indenture bearing Date the Day next before the Day of the Date of these presents
