In the Name of God Amen April the 29th Day anno Dom 1732: I William Easter of
princepsann County being sick & weak in body but of sound & perfect memory & Lord be
praised for it & calling to mind this Transitory Life & knowing that it is appointed for all
men once to Die & after Death to Judgment I commend my soul into the hands of almighty
God & most merciful Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ who hath redeemed it in full hope & assurance
and of the general resurrection at the last Day & my body to the Dust from whence of first
it was taken to be buryed in such Decent & Christian manner as shall be to the discretion
of my Ex^{rs} hereafter named & as touching my worldly goods wherewith I hath pleased
god almighty to bless me with I do dispose of the manner following viz: - I do give and
bequeath unto my son Thomas Easter one young horse Colt of one year old one hand mill
and one gun but my wife to have the use of the mill & horse during her widowhood - I do
give & bequeath to my daughter Frances Easter one mare called madone & one box Iron
but my wife to have the use of them while she remains a widow - I do give & bequeath
to my Daughter Mary Easter one small quilted Trunk to her I give the same of over
I do give & bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Easter the use of all the rest of my goods
chattels & residue remain & remainder of my Estate both with Doors & without the same
before given & bequeathed during her widowhood & after wards to be equally divided among
the nine Children being Thomas, Frances, Mary, Jacob, John, William, James
Abraham James Easter & I do nominate & appoint my Dear & Loving wife Mary Easter
the sole & sole Ex^{or} of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & fixed my Seals the Day and year first above written
