Easter will

In the Name of God Amen April the 29<sup>th</sup> Day anno Dom: 1732: I William Easter of  
princess ann County being sick & weak in body but of sound & perfect memory of Lord be  
praised for it & calling to mind this Transitory life & knowing that it is appointed for all  
men once to die after death to judgment I commend my soul into the hands of almighty  
God & most merciful lord & saviour Jesus Christ who hath redemeid it in full hope & assurance  
and of the general resurrection at the last Day & my body to the dust from whence it first  
it was taken to be buried in due & decent & Christian manner as shall be to the discretion  
of my Ex: hereafter named & Touching my worldly goods wherewithal I have please  
god almighty to blesse me with I do dispose of the manner following viz: - I give & giue away  
to my son Thomas Easter one young horse colt of one year old one hand mill  
and one gun but my wife to have the use of the mill & horses during her widowhood: - Then  
I giue & boquath to my daughter Francis Easter one mare called madone & one box iron  
but my wife to have the use of them while she remains a wid: - I give & giue away  
to my daughter Mary Easter one small guildd Trunk to her I giue the same of over  
I give & boquath unto my loving wife Mary Easter the use of all the rest of my goods  
chattels & residue remain & remainder of my Estate both within Dores & without the same  
before giuing & boquath to her during her widowhood after wards to be equally divided among  
her nine children being Thomas, Francis, Mary, Jacobin, John, William, James  
abraham James Easter & Benjamin & appoint my dear & loving wife Mary Easter  
the hole & sole Executour of this my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have  
hereunto set my hand & fixed my Seal the Day and year first above written
