 and perfect & once blessed be God for it & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to pass therefore
 thought fit to make this my last will & testament as follows. I give & bequeath my soul to almighty
 God who gave it and trusting that through the merits of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to receive full
 pardon & remission of all my sins & my body to be buried in the earth to be decently buried & for what worldly En-
 stant it hath pleased God to bless me with I give in manner following. I give & bequeath
 lying at Coramuch to be for my wife & provide of all my children to them & their heirs for ever
 I give & bequeath unto my Son Tho: Hunter all my crop of my lands & also to him his heirs for
 ever. I give & bequeath unto my loving wife & work & labour of my two negroes Dick & Sam
 ing & Term of her natural life & after her decease to my Son Tho: to whom I give & bequeath to him
 hours for ever I give unto my Son James & first child that my negro woman Diana shall bring
 to him & his heirs for ever. I give unto my Son Tho: my negro boy & Diana to him & his heirs
 for ever. I give unto my Son John my negro & Phillis & to him his heirs for ever. I give
 unto my Son James my negro girl called Sus to him & his heirs for ever. I give to my wife all
 my stock of hogs to do & dispose thereof as she thinks fit. I give & bequeath all my stock of cattle
 and sheep to be equally divided between my wife & three children Tho: James & John to them & their
 heirs for ever. I give unto my loving wife two feather beds & 4. furniture belonging to them to
 her & her heirs for ever. I give to my Son Tho: one dozen of new powder plates & two feather beds &
 furniture belonging to them to him & his heirs for ever. I give unto my two sons John & James one
 hundred pounds to be equally divided between them & to be laid out in land as they think fit when
 they come to age. to them & their heirs for ever. I give to my Son Tho: fifty pounds money to him on
 said Son & his heirs for ever. I order & appoint that my mare called piggson & mare I bought of William
 Lowery run for & use of my three sons & they together with their heirs to be equally divided amongst
 them when I & we shall come of age. I give unto my wife my own riding horse called Hornuch to be at
 disposal as she thinks fit & in case I said horse should die then I give her one of 4. so that she shall come of 4
 mares about given. I give all my pots & kettles of what kind soever to be equally divided between my wife
 & three sons Tho: James & John to whom I give & bequeath to them & their heirs for ever. I order & appoint that
 all & every one of my Estate not before given away be brought to appraisement. after my death & all
 and funeral expences are paid & surplusage to be equally divided amongst & between my wife & three

hours for Ever I give unto my Son James & for Ever I give unto him his hours for Ever - I give unto my Son Tho: my negro boy & Diana to him his hours for Ever: - I give unto my Son John my negro Philis to him his hours for Ever: - I give unto my Son James my negro girl called Sus to him his hours for Ever: I give to my wife all my stock of hogs to do & dispose thereof as she thinks fit: I give to my wife all my stock of sheep to do & dispose thereof as she thinks fit: I give to my wife all my stock of cattle to do & dispose thereof as she thinks fit: I give to my wife all my furniture belonging to her & her hours for Ever: - I give to my Son Tho: one dozen of new powder plates & two feather beds & furniture belonging to him to him his hours for Ever: - I give unto my two Sons John & James one hundred pounds to be Equally Divided between them to be laid out in land as they think fit when they come to age to them & their hours for Ever: - I give to my Son Tho: fifty pounds money to him on said Son & his hours for Ever: - I order & appoint that my mare called pigeon & mare I bought of William Lowery run for & use of my three Sons & they together with their heirs to be Equally Divided amongst them when & I do so shall come of age: I give unto my wife my own riding horse called Hornet to be at her disposal as she thinks fit & in case of said horse should die then I give her one of y^e foals that shall come of y^e mare about given: - I give all my pots & kettles of what kind soever to be Equally Divided between my three Sons Tho: James & John to whom I give & I give to them & their heirs for Ever: I order & appoint that all y^e rest & remainder of my Estate not before given away to be brought to appraisement & after my debts & funeral expenses are paid & surplusage to be Equally Divided amongst & between my wife & three Sons Tho: James & John to whom I give & I give to them & their heirs for Ever: I ordain & appoint my loving wife Margaret Hunter to go together with my Son: Tho: to be my whole Ex^{or} of this my last will & Testament. In witness & Confirmation of all above written I have set my hand & seal this 2. March 1718
