thought fit to make this my last will & Testament as follows - I give & bequeath my soul to Almighty
God who gave it and trusting that through grace of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to receive the
pardon & righteousness of almighty God my body to be decently buried after deathly end
- It is by the grace of God I now die in peace & my soul goeth to him & my body to the earth
bying at Cora he had to be for ever & provide of al my children to have their share for taxe &
I give & bequeath unto my Son Thos: Hunter all my lands where so ever to him his heirs for
ever - I give & bequeath unto my loving wife & work labours of my two negroes Suck & Suck
hours for I never gived unto my Son James & for a childe that my negroe woman Diana shall bring
to him & his heirs for ever - I give unto my Son Thos: my negroes Harry & Diana to him & his heirs
for ever - I give unto my Son Thos: my negro & white land to him & his heirs for ever - I give
unto my Son James my negro girl called Suck to him & his heirs for ever - I give to my wife also
my Stock of hoggets Do & dispose therof as I think fit - I give & bequeath my Stock of Cakes
and Sheep to be equally Dividid between my wife & the two Sons Thos & James & John to them the
heirs for ever - I give unto my loving wife two feather beds & 4 furniture belonging to them to
her other heirs for ever - I give to my Son Thos: one Dozen of new powder plates & two feather beds &
furniture belonging to them to him & his heirs for ever - I give unto my two Sons John & James or
hundred pounds to be equally Dividid between them & to be laid out in land as they think fit when
they come to age to them the heirs for ever - I give to my Son Thos: fifty pounds money to him on
his Son & his heirs for ever - I order & appoint that my marble'd pigeon house I bought of William
Lavery run for & use of my three Sons & they together with their increase be Equally Dividid amongst
them when y^e Eldest shall come of age - I give unto my wife my own riding horse called Poniell to both
disposale as she thinks fit & ready y^e said horse should die then I give her one of y^e fields that shall come of y^e
marble house given me - I give all my pots & kettles of what kind so ever to be Equally Dividid between my wife
& the two Sons Thos: James & John to whom I give my Glebe to them & their heirs for ever I order & appoint it
at y^e first & from time of my Estate not before & on day to be brought to appraisement after my life Do &
funeral expences are paid & Surplusage to be Equally Dividid amongst the two Sons & my wife & her
children & if there be any remainder left in the estate after paying all debts & expenses against my

them when & I shall be out of age: I give unto my wife my own riding horse called Pocahontas to be left
