at Laight soon yea or so & receive what I have here given him & of remainder of my
Estate Now I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Eliza Foster to her and
her heirs for ever & I do make her my he & sole Exe cutrix of this my last will
and Testament as witness my hand this third Day of may 1734
