 haven in County of Princeps Anne living in my perfect Health for Imp^r I God
 and Devise to my Son William Morris the Land and Plantations whereon
 he now lieth with the Appurtenances to him and his Heirs for ever as also I
 give and bequeath to my said Son William Morris the Bed and (Moss) which he
 has now in possession & also a Negro Girl Named Hannah and also a Desk after the
 Death of my loving Wife Elizabeth Morris But in Case my said Son William
 should at any time or times hereafter molest, disturb or with my said Thomas Mor-
 ris out of the Land and premises hereafter Given and Bequeath to him the said
 Thomas, that then the said Land and premises and all other the Appurtenances
 Together with the Bed and Moss and Negro Girl Hannah & Desk by me before
 Given to be utterly void and of no Effect & if so I Give him only one Shilling In full
 of his portion out of my Estate I Give and bequeath to my said Son Thomas Mor-
 ris the Plantations whereon I now live with all Houses, Orchards and other Appur-
 tenances due unto belonging to him the said Thomas I Give the same and to the
 Heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten But in Case he should die without such
 Heirs then I Give the said Land and Appurtenances unto my son Josiah Morris
 And in Case he should die without such Heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten
 Then I Give & Devise the same to Francis Morris Under the Heirs of his Body Law-
 fully begotten. I also Give and bequeath to my said Son Thomas Morris my bed
 and Furniture and also a Horse called Lightfoot & a Negro Boy Named Philip
 with a Desk and all the Creatures of any kind that is in his Mark & also my
 Black Gun. But in Case my said Son William Morris should with and reject my
 said Son Thomas out of the Land and premises before given him that then
 my said Son Thomas to have the Land before Given to said William to the said
 Thomas Morris & his heirs for ever. I Give and bequeath to my Son Arthur Morris
 One hundred and fifty Acres of Land first laid off out of three hundred Acres bought
 of my Brother Josiah Morris known by the Name of Appond, Clearing
 with all the rights and properties Belonging to the said Land to him and the
 Heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten for ever I likewise give and bequeath to my
 said Son Arthur a Negro Girl named Kate and also a Bed and Furniture and
 all the Creatures of any kind that is in his Mark and a Horse called with the
 said and key belonging to it and a Gun, and a horse named Spark to him and
 his heirs for ever. I Give and bequeath to my Son Asaph Morris One hundred
 and fifty Acres of Land more or less last laid off from the three hundred Acres above
 mentioned which I bought of my Brother Josiah Morris known by the Name
 of Longridge to him my said Son Asaph with all the rights and properties
 belonging to the said Land and to the Heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten
 for ever. And also I Give and bequeath to the said Asaph One Bed and Furniture
 together with a Negro Girl named Esther and a Chest with a Draw in it and
 all the Creatures of any kind in his Mark and likewise a Horse called Buck

with a Gun loaded my Ballas Gun to him for ever. I give
 son Francis Morris a Negro Wench named Sarah with her Children (scipie
 and Michael) and all her future Increase with a Bed and Furniture and a
 Black Horse & saddle known by the Name of Guinea and a Young Mare her
 Increase also all the Equipments of any kind In his Brother James Morris's Mare
 I also give and bequeath to my said son Francis all the Land and Houses (scipie
 to me known by the Name of Mercury Ridge Only my Will and Desire is that
 all his Brothers may have a privilege to put any kind of Questions upon the
 Marriage And further I give to my said son Francis a Gun which I thought of
 Hadrick Gregory I Give and Bequeath all the rest of my said Estate of any kind
 or sort whatsoever to my Loving Wife Eliz Morris During her Natural Life
 and after the Death of my loving Wife Elizabeth my Will and Desire is that
 all my Children may have an Equal Share provided they comply with every
 Article of this my said Will after the Decease of my said Wife Elizabeth Lastly
 I nominate and Appoint my loving Wife Elizabeth together with my sons William
 and Thomas Morris's my Executors of this my Last will and Testament making
 hereby all Other and former Wills by me heretofore made Null and Void
 this to be my Last Will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and Affixed my seal this third day of March 1752
