113 This Indenture made the Ninethenth day of September in the year of Our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred & Eighty Two Between Matthew Pallett of the County of Prince George in Virginia of the one part and Joseph White of the same place of the other part, Witnesseth that in consideration of Fifty pounds current money of Virginia taken in hand paid by the said Joseph White a too before the sealing and delivery of these Presents to the said Matthew Pallett he doth hereby Acknowledge & therewith Release Acquitt and discharge the said Joseph White his Executors Administrators by them present; Be the said Matthew Pallett hath granted, Bargained, Sold, Aligned and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, Bargain, Sell, Aligned and confirm unto the said Joseph White and his heirs all that Tract of Land which he has for several years been possessed off containing Four hundred Acres, be the same more or less, according to the most ancient known & reputed Boundaries thereof which said Land is part of a tract of Twelve Hundred & Fifty Acres granted by Patent to Anthony Sawson & Robert Hodge in the year 1600 to which refers and by Deed from Anthony Sawson given to a certain Anne Peeling & the Heirs of her Body lawfully Begotten & their Heirs for ever which said Deed bears date 1693 & to which likewise refers which said Anne Peeling by Marriage with a certain Robert Pallett had John Matthew Pallett her son born whom I claim; And all Houses Buildings Orchards, Ways, Paths, Caves, meadows, Woods, tanneries and appertinances whatsoever to the said Anne Peeling her by granted or to any part thereof belonging or in anywise pertaining; And the Residue & Reversions Remainder and Remainders unto Jones & posterity thereof
