 two slave wile & Rose to her & her heirs for ever: — I give unto my son adam Thoroughgood one
 young bay mare about four year old to him & his heirs — my will & desire is & I do hereby order
 & appoint that all my Stock of cattle & horses be & inventory & according to their quantity & quality
 be equally divided amongst & betwixt my wife & children to whom I give & I have — I give unto
 my son adam Thoroughgood my Trooping Saddle pistols & holsters & sword like wife my gun to him and
 his heirs for ever — my will & desire is & I do hereby order that all great residue & remainder
 of my Estate of what nature or quality so ever not otherwise disposed of be appraised & after all
 just debts & funeral Expenses abated & I have be equally divided betwixt my wife & children to
 whom I give & I have & to their heirs for ever — Lastly I nominate & appoint my loving wife
 Patience Thoroughgood & my kinsman m^r. Tho^s. Thoroughgood to be Executors of this my last will & Testament
