In the Name of God Amen I Anne Harrison of the County
of Prince William and Commonwealth of Virginia being
Sound in mind and memory do make and Ordain my Last
Will and Testament in the manner Following (Viz)
I Impairise To my Sister Seth Harrison I Give all the Lands
that was Devised to me by my Brother Cuthbert Harrison
To have and to hold to her my Said Sister in the Same manor
as I might or could hold them under my Said Brother
Cuthberts Will also to my Said Sister Seth I Give all my
right title & Interest in & to the Negroes left me by my
Said Brother as also two Negroes known by the Names of
Luke & Esther & the future increase of the Said Esther also an
Horse called Childres and my part of a riding chair and
the Looking Glasses purchased of the Estate of my Brother Cuthbert
Harrison also all my right to the mules & the Increase of a
Bee Mare purchased of the Said Estate of my Brother Cuthbert

5 Bay Mare purchased of the said Estate of my Brother Quothbert
to have and to hold to my said Sister & to her heirs for Ever.

Item to my Sister Elizebeth Scot I Give fifteen pounds
Virginia Currency to be paid her out of my Estate by
my Executrix hereafter mentioned —

Item to my
Sister Frances Short I Give a Negro called Peg, & in case
my said Sister Dies without Issue I then Desire that my
Sister Seth may have the said Negro Peg, to her and
her heirs forever —

Item to my Nephew Thomas
Harrison I Give a Negro called Spenced to be Delivered to him
when he arrives to the age of twenty one years or sooner

if my Sister Seth shall thing prosper, & in case my said
Nephew shall Die before he arrives to that age I Desire
that my Sister Seth may have the said Negro forever.

I further Desire that my Sister Seth may Keep the said

my Eccentrica hereafter mentioned — Item to my
Sister Frances Short I Give a Negro called Peg, & in case
my said Sister Dies without Issue I then Desire that my
Sister Seth may have the said Negro Peg, to her and
her heirs forever — Item to my Nephew Thomas

Harrison I Give a Negro called Spenced to be Delivered to him
when he arrives to the age of twenty one years or sooner
if my Sister Seth shall thing prosper, & in case my said
Nephew shall Die before he arrives to that age I Desire
that my Sister Seth may have the said Negro forever.

I further Desire that my Sister Seth may keep the said
Negro in her possession untill he is Delivered to my said
Nephew Thomas Harrison paying annually so long as
he keeps him the sum of five pounds to my Nephew

James Scott untill he comes of age and after the said Scott is of age then the
said five pounds to be paid to the said Thomas Harrison untill the
Negro Spencer is given up as aforesaid. I further Desire that if
my sister Seth shall chuse to give up the said Negro to Thomas
Harrison before he is of age that then my said sister Seth be
Discharged from paying the five Pounds & that the said Harri-
son pay five pounds annually to James Scott untill the
said Scott comes of age. Item to Frances Barris Harri-
son I Give a Negroe called Henry to her and her heirs forever.
Item to Mary anne Harrison Daughter of Col. Burr Harrison
and to Mary Stuart Alexander Daughter of Col. William
Alexander I Give a mourning ring each - Item I Desire
that all my stocks & Furniture not before Disposed of may
be sold to pay of my Debts & after my Debts are paid that the
residuum of the same be divided equally among the said

residuum of the money arising from the sale may be Equally Divided between James Scott & Nancy Scott the Children of my sister Elizabeth Scott. Lastly I constitute and appoint my sister Seth Harrison Sole Executrix of this my Last will and Testament revoking all other wills by me heretofore made in witness whereof I have hereto set my hand & seal this 13th Day of September the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty Three —
