 Cuthberts Prince William County, do make and ordain this my
 will Last will and Testament. I Give to my Grandson
 Grand. Cuthbert son of Alexander Bullitt, and His Heirs for
 ever, seven Hundred and fifty Acres of Land in Kentucky
 purchased by me of George Hays. I Give to my son
 Thomas Bullitt and His Heirs forever, my tract of
 Land lying in Quantico neck as the same has been
 conveyed to him in Trust, I also Give to him and his
 Heirs forever, all my Lands lying in ~~the~~ Fauquier
 County, containing the old tract of upwards of
 eight Hundred acres, also the Tract I purchased
 of the widow of the late Reverend John Scott containing
 upwards of Six Hundred acres, and also a Tract of
 upwards of two Hundred acres purchased of John
 Waller; And my said son paying the money that
 is due to the Parish of Dittington, & the Balance

5. is due to the Parish of Dittingen, & the Balance
which I still owe to Waller, having paid upwards
of one hundred pounds. I give further to my said son
Thomas & his Heirs forever out of my four tracts of land
lying upon the waters of Pleasant Run, ^{and} Reachfork
in Kentucky, fifteen Hundred acres of Land to be
lot off in a body. I give to my four Daughters, ^{Frances}
Sarah, Helen & Sophia, ^{To} Frances a negroe Girl now
in Her possession, Daughter of black & Kelly, also
the negroes now in Her Possession except the negro
Boy Hector. I give to my Daughter Sarah a negroe
Girl about ten or eleven years old the Daughter of
Kate now under my Overseer James Wood, as also
seven pounds Cash. I give to my Daughter Helen
and her Heirs forever the negroe Girl called Molly -
Daughter of Kelly. I give to my Daughter Sophia a negro
Girl named Jane, the Daughter of Hector. I give to my
three Daughters, Sarah, Helen & Sophia, five hundred

Sarah, Helen & Sophia, ^{to} Frances a negroe girl now
in her possession, Daughter of black Kelly, also

three Daughters, Sarah, Helen & Sophia, five hundred
pounds Cash, to be paid them in shares by equal
allotment a young fellow to be considered as worth
twenty five pounds, and a young man as
worth sixty pounds, and other slaves at the

of proportionable price as to be set apart as to make
these lots as equal as possible. I give to my wife and
children five pounds each to purchase them a mourning
ring. I give to my son Thomas my small sword.
I Desire so much of the Remainder of my Estate as there
may be cause for (after my Debts that can be collected
in a reasonable time shall be applied) to be sold by
my Executors and the Remainder of my said Debts to be
Discharged thereout. All the Rest and Residue of my
Estate after my Debts are paid. I Give to be Equally
Divided among my four Daughters, Frances, Sarah
Helen and Sophia, and their Heirs forever. The
small bequest in this my will to my wife is to
have no Effect ^{with respect} to her Dowry, it being my will that
she shall have the same exclusive. I Give further
to my four Daughters, Frances, Sarah, Helen, &
Sophia and their Heirs forever, four acres of land

Sophia and their Heirs forever, four acres of land
adjoining upon the Town of New Port & Potomac
River, as also the Lots undisturbed of in the said
Town except the Ferry Lots & Houses, which I give
to my son Thomas and his Heirs forever. I appoint
