monwealth of Virginia be in Sound & perfect
Memory do make Constitute & appoint this my
Last Will & Testament in manner & form fol-
lowing

Infirmities I give & bequeath to my Loving
Son Nathl Harrison all That tract or parcel of Land
I now possess lying & being on the South Side
of Cedar Run to the old Established line of the
Original tract taken up by my Grandfather
Thos Harrison to him & his heirs forever -
Item I give & bequeath to my Sisters Frances
& Ann Harrison all my other Lands adjoining
the above mentioned tract ^{to be} equally Divided be-
tween them & their heirs forever & they Assigning

of Cedar Run to the old established line of the
original tract taken up by my Grandfather
Thos Harrison to him & his heirs forever -
Item I give & bequeath to my Sisters Frances
& Ann Harrison all my other lands adjoining
the above mentioned tract ^{to be} equally divided be-
tween them & their heirs forever & they designing
Eight Acres of the said land to my Sister Seth
Harrison for the use of supporting the
land I have left my sister Seth (Harrison)
in Wood & Timber.

Item I give & bequeath to my beloved Sister
Elizabeth Seths one hundred pounds to be p-
aid of my estate to her within one year
after my death.

Sarah Harrison one hundred pounds to be paid out of my
Estate to her & her heirs for ever

Item ~~in~~ my will & Desire is that the lands I now
hold on the head branches of Chappewarnsick lying in the
Counties of Hafford & William be sold to discharge my Just
Dolls & if the money arising from the Sale of the said
lands shall be more than will pay my ~~Just~~ Dolls, that my
share the surplus be equally divided among my
five Sisters above mentioned

Item my will & Desire is that all my Real & Personal
Estate not before mentioned in this my last will be equally
divided between my five Sisters above mentioned (except one
Negro wench called Lucy which I bequeath to my beloved sister
Jeth Harrison & them & their heirs for ever

Lastly I constitute & appoint my beloved Sister Jeth Harrison

Wm Alexander executor of this my last will
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
20th day of October in the year of our Lord 1778

At a Court held for Prince Georges County the 7th day of Feby
1780. The last will of the said Harrison was presented
to the Court by the Esq^r & Es^{rs} herein named who made
oath thereunto according to law & being proved by the oaths of
two witnesses thereto is admitted to record & the said Esq^r
& Es^{rs} having done what is usual in ^{such} cases Certificate
is granted ~~to~~ them for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.
