givens unto Almighty God for it & calling toward the mortality of my body —
knowing it is appointed for all men once to die & ordains this my
last will & Testament that is to say first & principally I command my soul
into the hands of Almighty God that gave it nothing Doubting but at the
general resurrection to receive the same again by the mighty power of God.
of my body I command to the Earth to be decently buried at the direction
of my Executors hereafter named & as touching all such worldly Estates as
it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give devise and dispose
in the following manner & form.

First will that all my debts & funeral Expenses be Discharged.

Item given unto my Son George Fobbs one negro Slave named Tap Salter

Item given unto my Son Stephen Fobbs one negro Slave named little Jack

Item given unto my Daughter Harriet Fobbs one negro woman Slave —

named Sarah with her incroas to remain to the issue of her mother —

Harriet till the day of her marriage

Item given and bequeath unto my Dearly Beloved wife Harriet Fobbs two —

negro men Slaves named Jack and Abrams for and during her natural life

afterward to be redemeed to the abovenamed James & William Fobbs known as

their heirs for ever

Item given unto my Son James Fobbs one child — Frank —

I have given unto my Son William Tibbs one negro slave named great Jack

I have given unto my Son George Tibbs one negro slave named Tap Salone

I have given unto my Son Joshua Tibbs one negro slave named little Jack

I have given unto my Daughter Harriet Tibbs one negro woman slave —

named Sarah with her incroast to remain to the wife of her mother —

Harriet till the day of her marriage

I have given and bequeath unto my Dearly Beloved wife Harriet Tibbs two —

negro men slaves named Jack and Abrams for and during her natural life

Afterward to remain to the abovesigned James & William Tibbs known

their heirs forever.

I have given unto my Son James Tibbs one negro slave named Frank —

after the Death of his mother Harriet Tibbs valued & appraised which at

the age of fifteen years by my Executors the money to be equally divided

among my following four Sons & grandsons Tobbs William Tobbs George & Tibbs & Tufloe —

Tobbs

I have given unto my four grandsons & granddaughters all the Tract of Land whereon I now dwell to be equally divided between them, my four grandsons to have my Dwelling house at his mother's Dooage & that they pay yearly unto this said George & Tufloe Tobbs five hundred pounds of Tobacco each yearly for four years after this said George & Tufloe shall come to the age of twenty one years.

Item as also all my singulars my personal Estate to be valued and appraised in money —

& that it be equally Divided amongst my loving wife Carolot Tobbs & grandsons Tobbs William Tobbs George Tobbs & Tufloe Tobbs & my Daughter Carolot Tobbs.

Item I do likewise appoint ordain my loving friend John Diffins my Son in law &

William Tobbs his sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament ratifying —

holding and confirming this unto other to be my last Will & Testament so hereby

utterly revoked & cancel & to follow any other former wills or Testaments Legacies wills

or Bequests at any other time before by me made mentioned or intended should

conforming this and no other to be my last Will & Testament in writing whereof
I have put in further Testimony this day and year first above (Britton)

by the said Daniel Tobbs as his last Will &
