do make & ordain this to be my last Will & Testament in this following

my Executrix hereafter named and as for such worldly Estate it
hath pleased God to bestow upon me in this life I give to Bequattle and
disposse of the same in manner and form following.

I give and Bequattle to loving son James Doyle and the heirs of
his body lawfully begotten for ever the land and plantation I now
have on & forty acres of land adjoyning thereto on the North side of
the North run of Potow.

I give and Bequattle to my son Edward Doyle and the heirs of
his body lawfully begotten for ever eighty acres of land joyning to the
land given to my son James and running up the North Run of Potow
to my upper corner tree.

Item. I give and bequeath to my son James Doyle and the heirs of

the North run of Pohick.

Item. I give and bequeath to my son Edward Doyle and the heirs of
his body lawfully begotten for ever eighty acres of land joining to his
land given to my son James and running up the North Run of Pohick
to my upper corner tract.

Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Doyle and the
heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever seventy seven acres of land
the same being the remaining part of my tract, and if it so happens
that she dies without such heirs, my will is that the same be equally
divided betwixen my two sons James and Edward.

Item. I give and bequeath to my son James one third year old Horses.

Item. I give and Bequeath to my son Edward one thousand year old Heifer.

Item. I give and Bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth one two year old Heifer.

Item. My Will is that the Heifers given to my two sons may be paid them as soon as they shall attain the age of nineteen years, and that, that given to my daughter may be paid her when she attains the age of sixteen years, or after on demand.

Item. I give and Bequeath to my son James one Sow and five Piggs.

Item. I give and Bequeath to my son Edward one Sow and five Piggs.

Item. I give and Bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth one Sow and five Piggs.

Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my loving wife Priscilla Doyle to be my only and sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty ninth day of March one thousand seven hundred forty.
