 of Hamilton & County of Prince William Planter being sick & weak of
 body but of sound & perfect memory and Judgment (blessed be God)

and considering that the said of his approach of death is very uncertain and being
 desirous to settle & dispose of what estate God of his goodness hath bestowed upon me
 do make constitute appoint & ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form
 following hereby revoking annulling frustrating renouncing & making void all other
 Will or Wills Testament or Testaments by me heretofore made & declaring this only to
 be my last Will & Testament.

I purpise. I Bequeath my precious & immortal Soul to Almighty God my Creator
 assuredly hoping in & through the merits & mediation of my blessed Redeemer Jesus
 Christ for a full pardon & remission of all my sins. And my body to the Earth to be Christianly
 & decently interred according to the discretion of my Ex^{rs} aforementioned in full expect-
 ation of a blessed Resurrection to eternal life. And as concerning such worldly goods &
 estate as God of his goodness & mercy hath blessed me with my will & meaning is that the
 same shall be bestowed & employed as hereafter followeth, after ^{all} my just debts & funeral
 charges are paid Viz.

Item. I give devise & bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth unto the use labour &
 occupation of any man slave (up to) for & during her natural life & after her decease I
 give devise & bequeath the 3. slave to my beloved daughter Margaret unto & her heirs
 for ever.

Item. I give devise & bequeath to my 3. daughter Margaret my Negro female slave
 Elizabeth

Item. I give give & bequeath to my S^r. daughter Margaret my Negro female slave Sarah & her issue to her my S^r. daughter & her heirs for ever.

Item I give give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Mary Sute a Negro child named Jamie the son of Negro Sarah to her & her heirs for ever.

Item. I give and bequeath all my stock of Hogs & Cattle all the money now in my possession & all my other Goods & Chattels And all my Estate whether Real or Personal & being first converted into money to be equally divided amongst my wife & my daughter Margaret & my daughter Mary abovesmentioned.

finally I hereby nominate constitute appoint & ordain my trusty and beloved friends Thomas Harrison Jun^r. & Benjamin Bullock Gent. my sole & whole Ex^{rs} to this my last will & testament. I also appoint them the S^r. Thomas Harrison Jun^r. & Benjamin Bullock to be Guardians to my abovesmentioned beloved daughters till they shall arrive at the age of fourteen years.
