this 30th of March one thousand seven hundred & eighty three

This Last will and Testament of Foushee Tibles Gentleman Deceased
was presented to the Court by Willoughby Tibles an Executor thereof &
it appearing to the Court that the whole was written and subscribed
by his own hand Ordered the same be Recorded & ordered the Clerk at Law
be summoned the said Executor having performed what is
usual in such Cases Certificate is granted him for obtaining a prob-
ate thereof in Due form.
