him and his heirs for ever.

Item the said James Delgarn is to return the future increase
of the said Negro Charity unto the rest of my Children

hereafter named to be delivered at one year old the first
unto my son John Delgarn the next unto William Delgarn
and next unto my Daughter Elizabeth Gask and the next
unto Maryann Delgarn. Item I give and bequeath unto my

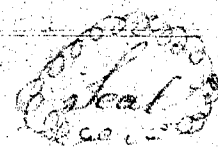
son George Delgarn one negro Gask named Rachael to him
