Item Give unto my Son John Friedrich Fishback a hundred and twenty Aqers of Land mor or less lying on the South East side of Chancere on Carter Line

Item I Give to my Son Harmon Fishback ^{Item} John Jacob Fishback John Philip Fishback ^{Item} & Jofie Fishback ten Hundred & twenty aqers of Land for to be divided in four parts every one having a Equall share of the said Land Lying on Hunger Run on the Branch of Goose Creek

Item I Give to my son Henry Fishback two hundred Aqers of Land more or less in the little fork of Chaphnach on the north River

Item I Give my son Friedrich Fishback a two year Old mear

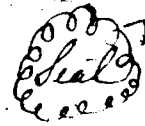
