NB I leave all what I have to my wife for the Support of her
and Small Children During her life or widow hood and after Death
th or Anter maring to be Equally Divided amongst my Children
except the Child now in Travel should be a girl so to have five

NB I leave My son W. M. Rose to Col. M. Rose.

NB I leave my son John Washington Rose and George Rose and as my wife is now in travel and not knowing whether Boy or Girl I leave them under her Direction untill they are able to go to trades by the Direction of Col. Blackburn & John Sweden.

NB I leave all what I have to My wife for the Support of her and some Children During her life or widowhood and after Death or Antis maring to be Equally Divided amongst my Children except the Child now in Travel should be a girl to have five pounds more than the Rest and if my wife should Die Before my Children come to the age of twenty one years the whole to be sold and the Money put on Interest and the Children paid of as they come to age.

NB if any one of them shall commit a Crime with

years he shall not have any part of what I leave this Every
Master shall note Down to them in or under his charge
four time a year at least as witness my hand the Date above
