The Last Will & Testament of John Walker of Wills -

Primed Wills and County being weak in body but in p[er]fect mind and memory that he do give in
to Almighty God for the same and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die and -
coming to rise again at the last day in glory everlasting.

First I doquath my soul to God that gave it, and my body to the Earth to be decently interred at the direction of my executors. And likewise I do declare and make Void all former Wills and Legacys by me made from the beginning of the World to this day -
And do Appoint and Constitute this to be my last Will and Testament.

I M[y]M[on]I[st] I give and bequeath what Estate I am possessed with to Sons or
Heirs of Rob^t and Jamis Walker they being the nearest of kin to me after my debts -
and Legacies are paid being all born in the Parish of Morston in Parson Dene in the County
of Northumbria in North Britain

Item I give and bequeath to the Poor of that Parish twenty pounds Sterling for
ever to be lodged in the hands of the Minister or Elders of the Church to be laid out in
punds or what they think proper that the Interest of it may support the Poor of the
Parish of Morston. And that there may be a stone erected within the Church and En-
graved thereon Capital Letters mentioning the Donor John Walker of North of

or good thordon Capital Letters mentioning the Donor John Walker Merchant of
Virginia

Item I give and bequeath to Mary Stevens fourty pounds or four thous
pounds of £^o at the Discretion of my Executor which he pleases to pay.

Item I do set at liberty Mr Sam Poll he not demanding freedom I doe thirty-
or forty Shillings of small Goods out of my Store to be delivered by my Exec^t

Item I give unto Leonard Barker five yds of Plains that's in my Store to make
him a Suit of Cloaths.

I do appoint my trusty and well beloved friend Mr Leonard Barker my whole and
sole Exec^t of this my last Will and Testament as Trustee my Estate and I doe this
5th Day of December 1736 and also my last bequeath to Barker as I had of
Sct Hammon
