lands or what they think proper that the Interest of it may support the Poor of the
Parish of Wrotham And that there may be a Stone Erected within the Church and En-

Item I give and bequeath to Mary Stoen forty pounds or four thousand pounds of Tob^o at the Discretion of my Executor which he pleases to pay.

Item I do set at Liberty In^o Campbell he not demanding Freedom I do thirty or forty Shillings of small Coins out of my Store to be delivered by my Ex^r

Item I give unto Leonard Barker two y^d of Phins that in my Store to make Linna Suit & Cloaths.

I do Appoint my trusty and well beloved friend M^r Leonard Barker my whole and sole Ex^r of this my last Will and Testament as Witness my Hand and Seal this 5th Day of November 1736 and also my Seal bequeath to Barker as I had of
Sc^t Hammer
