Accepted, and my Body to the earth.

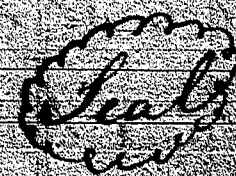
Item I Give to my Brother William ashmore my Negro Fellow
