Item I Give and Bequeath unto my said Daughtes Ann Gay Ismonger
my Best Bed & Furniture Consisting of three Blanketts Two Bed
quilts Two pillows and Bedstead also a large Chest with Lock & key
also all my potts pan plates Dishes & all other kitchen Furniture

also all my potts pan plates Dishes & all other kitchen Furniture
that I may pose to her & her heirs Lawfully begotten of her Body.
Lastly It is my Desire that the above mentioned Negro Womans ~~For~~^{Income} and
her Increase to be put to the best use in Bringing up all my Children
untill my said Daughter Ann Guye Emonged Should Come
of age to take them upon her Self and I also Leave my Loving
Father Mark Mattheus Mankin as my Loving Brother
Benjamin Muggrove Mankin Executors to this my Last
will and Testament In Witness whereof I do hereunto set my
