Know all men by these presents that we Benjamin Grayson
and Cuthbert Harrison gent: are held and firmly &
bound unto Thos:as Harrison Junr: Valentine Peyton & Weston
Wm: Bertrand & well gentlemen Justices of the County of
Court of Exchequer William in the full and just sum of five & ~~one~~
hundred pounds Sterling to the which payment well and truly
to be made we bind ourselves and each of us jointly and ~~severally~~
severally for the whole and in the whole our and each of
our heirs executors and adm'rs to the said Justices their heirs and
successors firmly by these presents witness our hands and seals
this twenty fifth day of April 1743

The tendition of this obligation is such that the above
bened Benjamin Brayton executer of the last will and ~~test~~
testament of Narmaduke Garrison deceased do make or cause
to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular
the lands Chattels and credits of the said deceased which have
or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of him or
the said Benjamin Brayton or into the hands or possession
of any other person or persons for him and the same so
made to exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the County
Court of Prince William at such time as he shall be thereto
required by the said Court and the same lands Chattels or
and credits and all other the lands Chattels and credits of the

account of his goods and chattels heretofore given therunto &

and deliver all the legacies contained and specified in the
