Mare called Boiny, one cow & calf, a bed & furniture two pewter dishes six
plates an Iron pott a ewe & Lamb 2 Barrows & two brooding Sows.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Anne Drakefoot & to my son
John Drakefoot all the residue & remainder of my Estate after my just debts
& Legacies are paid & I do hereby constitute & appoint them the said Anne &
John Drakefoot to be the sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament intirely
revoking & disannulling all former Wills & Testaments. In Witnes whereof
