Decease to be sold to my brother Christopher Neale to him & his heirs forever

Item my Will & pleasure is that my Dear beloved wife Lydia Neale has the use &

benefit of my negro man named Lipo my negro woman named Lucy my

little daughter named Ann Dixon & likewise I give & bequeath to my loving

wife Lydia Neale all the remainder of my estate real & personal during her

my wife Lidia should have all the remainder of my estate real & personal during her
natural life & after her Decease the said Estate given to my beloved wife Lidia
should be equally Divided between my beloved brother Prosper & Verde &
my beloved brother Daniel & Verde & my beloved Sister Francis & Verde to
have their heirs for ever.

And I appoint my beloved wife Lidia & Verde & my beloved brother Christopher
