Item I give and Bequeath to my Son Samuel ^{Jackson} one Negro
Woman namelt Esther also one Negro Girl namelt Calista also one Negro man namelt

With also one Negro man named James also one Negro Girl named Lucy
 and whereas I have formerly given W. Will of Sale to my Son Samuel Jackson
 for his Discharge a Bond of mine due to Mr William Carr my Will
 and Desires that he be Satisfied out of the use of my Estate for the
 Discharging of the Sd Bond the cotton to wind I have given him the Sd
 Negro man James for his discharging of same Bond, Also give him one
 Chest with some Caps & Cloth & so on on on on on on on on
 More I have Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Rich one Negro Girl
 named Bethe also one Negro Woman named Sue also one Negro Boy
 named Shadrack & so on on on on on on on on on on on on
 I like have one Negro man named Abraham to be sold and the money to
 be Equally Divided between George Jackson & Samuel Jackson Sons
 of James Jackson, I also have one Negro man named Dick to be
 sold and the money to be Equally Divided between Samuel Jackson
 Son of George Jackson Jun^r and Charles Jackson Son of Samuel Jackson
 Jun^r and all my Real Estate Goods and Chattels to be Equally divided amongst
 all my children & I have also given my just Debt is fully paid & so on

And I have signed and sealed, after my just debts is justly paid in money

Equally divided Between my three Granddaughters Susanna and
Robert and Nancy the daughters of my son Francis Jackson
I do hereby bequeath my two sons George Jackson & John Jackson
