I give & bequeath to my loving daughters Elizabeth Sumner & Mary

Pick my Wearing Apparel to be equally divided between them and no more

Item I give and bequeath to my loving Daughter Annemah Williams five

shillings Sterling and no more, Item I give and bequeath to my loving

Daughter Frances Jobel five shillings Sterling and no more, Item

I give & bequeath to my loving son John Thown all the remainder

of my estate to him and his heirs forever, Item I leave my loving

I give & bequeath to my loving son John Thorne all the remainder
of my estate to him and his heirs forever, And I leave my loving
son John Thorne executor of this my last Will & Testament in
Witnes Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & fixed my seal this 8th
Day of November 1782
