Will

Examined

In the name of God Amen. I Scarlot Haworth of
Prince William County being sick & weak but of sound & perfect
sense & memory do by these presents make appoint & ordain this my
last Will & Testament in manner & form following
I Give & Bequeath to my loving wife Anne Haworth the Plantation
where

where we formerly lived commonly called or known by the name of the
 Old field with the land adjoining thereto, together with four Negroes viz
 Coo, Boff, Kato & Bristol & a third part of my stock & household goods &
 during her natural life & after her decease the land to descend to my son
 John & his heirs, & the Negroes to be equally divided between my son &
 daughter John & Anne Hantoko & their heirs.

Item I give & bequeath to my loving daughter Anne Hantoko the
 plantation in the forks of the creek where William Davis now lives with
 all the land belonging thereto to her & her heirs for ever, Item. I give &
 bequeath to my said daughter Anne Hantoko four Negroes viz?
 Tit's Sharp, Sarah & Giles, & a third part of all my stock & household goods.

Item. I leave & bequeath to my loving son John Hantoko the planta-
 tion whereon I now live in the Neck on Murrumbidgee Creek & all the land
 thereto belonging as also a four hundred acres of land left me by Richard
 Brett (as will appear by the said Brett's will) to him & his heirs for ever.
 Item. I leave & bequeath to my said son John Hantoko four Negroes
 viz? Moro, Galba, Poll, & Jacob & a third part of all my stock & household
 goods.

Item it is my will & desire that Negro Dick be sold for the most that can

be gott for him.

Lastly I Ordain & Appoint my loving wife Anne Haworth, John Grogg
Marmaduke Sawfon & Moses Sinton Executors of this my last Will
& Testament

At a Court hold for Prince William County March 23rd 1740.

This Will was presented in Court by Anne Haworth, John Grogg & Marmaduke
Sawfon three of the Executors therein named (Moses Sinton the other Executor
refusing the burthen thereof) who made Oath thereto & the same being proved
by the Oaths of Ambrose Howlot Simon Gosling, & Mary Watfon three of the
witnesses was admitted to Record. And on the motion of the said Executors and
their performing what is usual in such cases Certificate was granted them
for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.
