Buried in Decent and Christian Burial at the Direction of my
Exors and as touching such worldly estate as it hath Pleased God
to Bless me with in this life I give Devise and Bequeath
In the following manner and form following, Impressed I
give and Bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife Clara all my estate
both real and personal during her natural life but if she marries my
Estate to be taken from her and given unto my two Sons John &
Robert Dagg in following manner.

Item I give and bequeath all my estate both real and personal
after my Just Debts are paid and upon my wife Clara's Decease
unto my sons John and Robert Dagg to be equally Divided between
them and their heirs for ever.

Item If my wife Clara marries my estate both Real and
Personal be taken from ^{her} and Divided equally between my two
Sons John and Robt. Dagg to them and their heirs for ever

Lastly I constitute and appoint my dear & beloved wife in
Conjunction with her brother William Powell to be sole executor
and Escutor of this my last Will and Testament Revoking
And Disannulling all former Wills Legacies and Bequests
Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last will and
Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Affixed my seal the year and day above written
