followeth first I will that my debts and funerall charges
shall be discharged - I priuimis I give devise and bequeath
unto John Jordans five sons Elomas Jordan and Francis
Jordan one hundred and four acres of land to be equally

quantity of land herein mentioned

I from I give devise and bequdath unto my son John Jordan all
the remainder part of the whole tract which I am now in
posost with

I from I give devise and bequdath unto my two daughters a
tract of land lying near the naked mountain containing two
hundred and eighty and seven acres to be equally divided between
them this oldest to have her first choice I from I give and bequdath
unto Jen Rejaltie a two year old hoffer on mark I from I give
and bequdath unto George Lardin a young five year old hovse
and all the remainder part of my estate both movables and
unmovables within and without I leave to be sold to disfiaze
my debts and if there is more then will disfiaze my debts to be
equally divided amongst my children and his plantation I
leave line where to be reuted till my son comes of age and this

now lives upon to be rented till my son comes of age
rents to be for the schooling of my children Daniel Glearz
and John Dunstan I do appoint my Executors or Executors of this
my present last will and Testament february 4th 16th day 1743/4
