the Remainder of my Land unto my Son George Stone
to him and His Heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten

My son Thomas Stone that part of my Land where

my loving wife Sarah Stone one third part of my
Estate both Real and Personal during her natural
life & after her decease I give the same unto my
son George Stone. Item I give unto my children
hereafter mentioned Vizt. George Stone and
Sarah Bradfield and my loving wife Sarah
Stone (if she chuses it) rather than what has
already been willed her all the remainder of my
Estate after my Just debts are paid to be equally
divided among them and their Heirs forever —
Item I give unto my son James and my Daughters
Mary Leatherwood & Elizabeth Bradfield one
shilling sterling each to them and their Heirs for

ever Lastly I do hereby constitute and ordain
my loving wife Sarah Stone and my son George

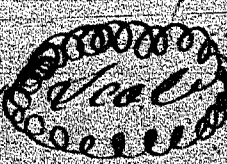
