And that it is appointed for all men once to die & being desirous  
That no Difference should arise after my Decease about what  
estate I have God of his Infinite goodness hath Mercifully  
bestowed on me after all my Just Dotts & funeral Expenses and  
paid my will & Desire in that it be disposed of in the manner &  
form following Viz. Inprimis I lend unto my beloved  
wife Elizabeth for her life & plantation whereon I now live  
Being 150 acres with all the appurtenances thereunto  
belonging together with my whole Estate both Real & personal  
During her Natural life & after her Death I give that  
same unto Tho<sup>s</sup> Leachman & his wife Elizabeth and to  
their heirs and assigns for ever and my will & Desire is that  
Tho<sup>s</sup> Leachman and his wife Elizabeth take Care of my wife and the  
Management of my Estate and apply it to the use & benefit of my  
Loving wife during her life and That my Desire is that my Estate  
may not be appraised nor taxed for the first 10 years after my death

may not be approved nor inventoryed but that the S<sup>r</sup> Leachman  
do pay all my just Debts And lastly I do hereby ordain &  
appoint the S<sup>r</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup> Leachman my whole & sole Executor of this  
my last will & Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and seal this 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1777.
