Item I give & bequeath unto my son William Powell Fifty acres of Land
 adjoining the land I before give him Deeds for to be laid of as follows
 Beginning at a white Oak Corner to John Cannon & myself Standing in a
 line of marked Trees between me & J. Cannon & running from thence a straight
 line to a forked Red Oak near the Corner of my fence from thence a straight
 line with ^{the} same course to the Rafterbree Branch from thence down the
 said Branch to John Brett Corner or the Maple branch including fifty
 Acres more or less to him the said William Powell his heirs and assigns
 forever—

Item, I give & bequeath unto my son Preston Powell the Plantation he
 holds under lease from me to James Legg & Sixty acres of Land to be added
 therunto in the form following. Beginning at a white Oak Corner
 mentioned in the lease & running from thence to a small white oak
 and two Red Oak Corners to Bernard Hoce & myself from thence with
 said Hoce line to Delanies from thence down Delanies R. line untill it
 intersects with the Dividing line mentioned in the lease under

who if she dies without Lawfull Issue then to her Sister Elizabeth Powell
and after her if without Lawfull Issue ^{to} her Brother William Powell
his heirs & assigns for ever

Item, I Give and bequath unto my Grand Daughter Sarah Powell
the Daughter of Leven Powell all my tract of Land laying in Loudoun
County on Little River ^{that} took up joining to Walter Scotts tract and
Meuer to her & her heirs Lawfully begotten for ever.

Item, I Lend my loving wife Elinor Powell all my Estate both Real
and personal During her Natural life or widowhood she Committing no
waste & at her Death I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Powell
the whole of that I before lent my wife Elinor Powell except
what I have before given & after all my Just Debts is paid to her
the S. Elizabeth Powell her heirs Lawfully begotten for ever or her
assigns who if she Dies without Lawfully Issue then to her Brother

William Powell his heirs or assigns forever —
