almighty God my worldly Goods as follows viz -

half the house I now live in, the third of my Land and one third
one Feather Bed and Furniture one scire more one cow and two
Ewes one pot one large Chest & large Table During her life &
after her Death to belong to my son Lewis Sackett

I give & bequeath to my son Lewis Sackett all my Land

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after my wife has the third of it I shall the house I now
live in one Negro girl named Pat one Sea Chest one Bed & furniture
one Bay main and Cottom one Cow and Calf four Sheep one Sow &
pigs one Basket one Dish & the plates To be Delivered To my
son Lewis Sachett when he arrives to the age of eighteen years

& my Desire is that my son Lewis Sachett shall have a African boy
by the name of Joseph Bue Mahan for his own use at my Death
further my Desire is that I leave one negro woman named Mary
and all the rest of my estate except one transfer one gilt & one silver

to my granddaughter Mitred for the maintenance of my
wife & my son Lewis Sachett and at the Death of my wife the
whole to fall to my son Lewis Sachett & the whole I have left him

whole to fall to my son Lewis Tackett & the whole I have left him
John and his heirs forever. To be me without more lawfully
begotten of his body. To be equally divided between my son
Wm Tackett Mary Hedges Elizabeth Bennet & further
Desire That the part of the estate of Thos Tampus Due
due me at the Death of Mary Tampus his wife I have my had
some part be properly settled by my Executors & his and the balance
Due me To be equally divided between my five children Wm
Tackett Lewis Tackett Mary Hedges Elizabeth Bennet &
likewise Ordain constitute and appoint William Blake My
& Lewis Benn my sole Executors of this my last will & Testament
confirming this and other to be my last will and Testament

Desire That the part of the Estate of Thomas Stampes Due
due me at the Death of Mary Stampes his wife I having had
some part be properly settled by my Executors & his and the balance

Due me To be Equally Divided Between my four Children Wm

& Lewis Reno my Sole Executors of this my Last will & Testament
