the general Resurrection I Shall receive it again by the
Almighty power of God and for my Estate where with it hath
pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and
Dispose of as follows Viz. I Give and bequeath
to my loving wife

God, now before calling to mind and knowing that it is
Appointed for all men once to die do make and order this &
No other my last will and Testament that is to say —
Principally and first of all I give and Recommend my

 Braden Crook & my loving brother Abraham Crook my only &
 sole Executors of this my last will & Testament In Witness Whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and Seals this day and year first
 Above written Signed & Sealed to be my last will & Testament
