Will

I Sebastian Mygatt of the County of Pulaski and State of Virginia, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make, ordain and publish this my last will and testament.

Item the First; I give all my just debts and just expenses to pay.

Item the Second; I will and bequeath to my wife Cynthia Mygatt the management and control of the farm on which I now live, during her natural life and it is my will that my wife Cynthia Mygatt pay one half, the same unto my people if the same farce to my wife Cynthia Jane Mygatt, and my nephew Sebastian Mygatt
Child of my brother Berdine Mygatt, jointly during her life.

I further will and bequeath to my said wife Cynthia Mygatt the management and control of my house and lot at Dublin Depot in the County of Pulaski and State of Virginia known as the Castle to me a person or persons by John R. Hollings, this it is my will that my wife Cynthia Mygatt pay one half the same, rents and profits of the said house and lot, to my said wife Cynthia
Mygatt and my said nephew Sebastian Mygatt (Children of my brother Berdine Mygatt) jointly, during her life, & further will and bequeath to my wife Cynthia Mygatt, one half of all money and funds, I may have at the time of my death and one half of the pecuniary possessions of the estate of above herein to be made by my executors.

Item the Third; I will and bequeath to my nephew Sebastian Mygatt son of my brother Berdine Mygatt the tract of land on which I now live containing two hundred and twenty five (25) acres more or less to go to him the said Sebastian Mygatt at the expiration of my wife Cynthia Mygatt's life estate, & further will and bequeath to the said Sebastian Mygatt my first watch. I further will that the sum of one hundred dollars be paid to the heirs of my brother Berdine Mygatt who are living at the death of my wife Cynthia Mygatt and his coming into possession of the pecuniary estate, pay to my nephews John H. Clegg the sum of one hundred dollars, and to my nephew Sebastian Mygatt daughter of my brother Berdine Mygatt the sum of one hundred dollars.

Item the fourth; I will and bequeath to my wife Cynthia Jane Mygatt the sum of

of my brother Berdine Mygatt my house and lot at Dublin Depot in said County and
four and one-half acres of land lying between the lands of John Hollings and George
Fleming to lie to her the said Cynthia Jane Mygatt at the expiration of my wife Cynthia
Mygatt's life estate therein.

Item the Fifth; I will and bequeath to my wife Cynthia Jane Mygatt and my nephew Sebastian
Mygatt Children of my brother Berdine Mygatt one half of all my rents and profits arising
thereat the time of my death and one half of the pecuniary possessions of the estate of my
house after deduction to be made by my executors, & one half of the rents and profits
arising out of my home farm among them as also at Dublin Depot before mentioned
during my wife's lifetime and further half and one half of the pecuniary possessions of the
estate of the said Cynthia Jane Mygatt and Sebastian Mygatt either if a third of the prop-
erty left and one person hereinafter bequeathed to each party thus dying estate to
the other surviving party.

Item the Sixth; I will and bequeath to my nephew John H. Clegg my unenclosed lot of land
lying at Dublin Depot in the County of Pulaski and State of Virginia, which I purchased
of Stephen Carter, and adjoining the lands of John D. Hobbs on the east and Thomas
Mygatt's house on the west. I further will and bequeath to the said John H. Clegg my tract of
land containing twenty six (26) acres more or less lying and being situated in the County
of Roanoke and State of Virginia, which lands I purchased of Hezekiah Clegg & his son the
latter of Barnes, I further will and bequeath my said nephew Stephen Sebastian Mygatt
son of my brother Berdine Mygatt shall at the death of my wife Cynthia Mygatt pay to
my said nephew John H. Clegg the just and fair sum of One hundred and
fifty dollars.

Item the Seventh; I hereby direct that my executors herein after named sell or public
auction all my just personal property.

Item the Eighth; I hereby nominate and appoint my nephew John H. Clegg my law-
ful Executor to execute this my last will and testament, and I desire that the said
John H. Clegg shall not be required to enter into any bond for the faithful performance
of his duties as such executor.

Item the Ninth; I hereby revoke and disuse all former wills and testaments
by me made, and declare this writing to be my last will and testament, Given
under my hand and seal this the 16th day of January 1870.
