Almond to me bearing date on the 13th day of August 1860, and of record in the books of the County of Rappahannock County, certain property located in said Deed is granted and conveyed to me with special Warranty for and during the term of Natural life and at my death to my lawful Child or Children, and in the event of my dying without lawful issue surviving me, then to any one or more of my relatives being descendants of my Father William Porter dec'd and as I may by my last will and Testament duly executed to pass lands limit and appoint. Now therefore I James W. Porter of the County and State aforesaid, do hereby bequeath to my Nephew Daniel W. Mason the said property conveyed to me in said deed if the said Daniel W. Mason shall survive me. But if the said Daniel W. Mason should die before me then I bequeath the said property to James W. Williams the Son of John W. Williams deceased who married Mary H. Mason the daughter of Daniel Mason deceased, all being my relations, and descendants of my Father William Porter deceased, dec'd. And I hereby nominate and appoint the said Daniel W. Mason Executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills and Testaments, given under my hand and seal this 16th day of March 1869. James W. Porter (Seal)

Under and Pursuant to the order of this Court made at the term thereof in the year 1868 appointing me a Special Commissioner to settle the accounts of Mrs. Polina B. M. Garck, Administratrix of Maria M. Garck deceased. I have made said settlement and by leave to report that Mrs. M. Garck must include only personal property, there being a sufficiency of personal property to pay the settlements of the estate. Mrs. P. B. M. Garck took the personal property of her intestate at the price to which the same was appraised by Commissioner duly appointed by the Court, to the amount of \$14891.50 in specie, which I reduced to currency as most of the settlements of the estate was in currency. And I have therefore charged Mrs. M. Garck with the whole of the personal estate of David M. Garck deceased and give her credit for the payments made by her for the estate. And there upon I find her due the estate the sum of \$4619.46 of the value in specie of \$576.46 which I report as the amount in her hands for distribution.
