 The foregoing statement presents
 a settlement of the accounts of William Mann as Admin-
 of Joseph Clark dec'd. And shows a balance in his hands
 of Twelve Thousand Two hundred and sixty seven dollars
 & thirty eight cents (\$12,267.38) In the matters of these bonds
 in which there was litigation, they being settled, Mann
 arranged the whole account, and charged the Admin-
 with the judgments obtained by him against the parties,
 with interest on all the bonds in his hands & the judg-
 ments up to the 1st of June 1869, less one year, as to the Un-
 bonded. Mann charges the Admin- with interest from the 1st
 of May 1865, to the 1st of June 1869, less one year, bearing
 the interest during the war.
