There has preceding statement that the condition of the accounts of Thomas P. Bass, as guardian of the infant heirs of Andrew Muschua decd. each statement showing the balance due to the same, with whom the account is stated, except the commission to which the guardian would be entitled upon disbursing the funds. The first statement, viz. that with Peter P. Muschua only shows the amount of commission to which the guardian would be entitled out of the deposit of that sum. It is proper however that I should report that the balances shown by these statements do not carry interest, although interest is now accruing (but not collectable) upon the funds which form part of each balance. It is therefore for future years it will become proper to charge the guardian with the interest as it becomes payable, and to credit each Legatee with his apportioned part of it. The future calculations of interest in favor of the same case should be taken to deduct from the balance alone reported, ~~the~~ value of the interest which form part of these balances.
