Will

I do hereby constitute and appoint my brother George W. Wyse executor of  
this will and guardian of my two infant sons John D. Baskerville and  
George I. Baskerville.

Secondly: I devise all my real estate situated here by me in severalty or  
jointly with others & whether lying in this State or in the State of Illinois  
to the said George W. Wyse in trust that he will manage and conduct the  
same for the use and benefit of my two infant sons as herein directed their  
minority; and upon the further trust that the yeares of my said sons attain-  
ing the age of twenty one years that he will convey the legal title to the real  
estate aforesaid to them & their heirs jointly to be afterwards equally divided be-  
tween them: But if at any time during the minority of my said sons the  
said George W. Wyse should deem it most to their advantage to sell any portion  
or the whole of said real estate, and to invest the proceeds of sale in other real  
estate, or in interest paying stock or bonds, he is hereby invested with the  
legal title and clothe with full power and authority at his own discretion  
to do so.

Thirdly: It is my will and desire that my personal estate except my  
clothes & except also such articles as my executor may think proper to re-  
tain for the use of my children shall be converted into money and after  
the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses be invested together  
with the annual rents of the real estate, or the proceeds of its sale & the pro-  
fit of the same, at interest for the maintenance & education of my said sons  
the said sum for accomplishing these purposes to be equally divided

between them upon their attaining the age of twenty one years: should they ever  
arrive at full age to have advanced to have such sum as my executor shall  
think equitable and just; and in the event of the death of either of them  
nationed upon before arriving at full age the whole is to go to the survivor.  
Fourthly: It is my desire that my executor shall farm and graze the land  
I have in Kentucky, Tennessee and not by selling to others as I do not wish it  
immediately changed. I myself wish to remain in Kentucky until my  
debts are paid and the balance of the same at two or more impartial men  
shall be paid him: it is my wish that he hire the negro by present contract  
& not at public auction so that they may have suitable quarters and proper  
treatment & housing.
