Snow. Know all men by these presents,
that I Samuel Snow in the County of Pulaski and
State of Virginia in full health and of sound and
disposing mind and memory do make and publish
this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all
former wills by me at any time heretofore made
First, I hereby constitute and appoint Stillman
B. Snow to be my sole Executor of this my last
Will, directing my said Executor to pay all
my just debts and burial expenses and legacies
hereinafter given out of my Estate
To my Son, Erasmus Morrison Snow Ten Dollars
To my daughter, Eliza Jane Ballard One Hundred
and fifty dollars
To my Son, Thomas Snow One Hundred dollars
To my daughter, Minnie Snow One Hundred dollars
And if mine shall be an orphan after paying
all expenses herein mentioned, It shall be divided
between my three last named Children in the
ratio above mentioned, If however my Will
that should my natural life be in the year of
providence prolonged beyond the 1st of April
1870, that my Executor shall cause to be paid to
Stillman B. Snow, or order Twelve dollars per month
for my board for the remainder of my life.
I further mean well that Stillman B. Snow
shall have all of my personal property at my
death Signed with my own hand this 3rd

day of February 1870

Motion of the said J. R. Snow. It is granted that Joseph
H. H. Davis, J. R. Miller and J. H. H. Davis being first
duly sworn, do truly and justly appraise, or cause
to be appraised, the personal estate of the said Samuel Snow
dec'd. and return their appraisement under their
hands to this Court
