State of Virginia. Make this my last Will
and Testament in manner and form following.
Whereas by the provisions of a Deed from William
R. Almond to me bearing date on the 13th day of
August 1860, and of record in the books of the County
Court of Rappahannock County, certain property here-
to in said Deed is granted and conveyed to me with
special Warranty for and during the term of Natural
life and at my death to my lawful Child or Chil-
dren, and in the event of my dying without lawful
Issue surviving me, then to any one or more of
my relatives being descendants of my Father William
Porter deceased as I may by my last will and
Testament duly executed to pass lands limit and
appoint. Now therefore I James W. Porter of the
County and State aforesaid, do hereby devise and bequeath
to my Nephew Daniel W. Mason the said Deed
and conveyed to me in said deed if the said
Daniel W. Mason shall survive me. But if the
said Daniel W. Mason should die before me
then I devise the said property to James W.
Williams the Son of John W. Williams deceased
who married Mary W. Mason the daughter
of Daniel Mason deceased, all being my
relatives, and descendants of my Father William
Porter deceased, decd. And I hereby nominate
and appoint the said Daniel W. Mason Executor
of this my last Will and Testament, hereby rev-
oking all other Wills and Testaments, Given under
my hand and Seal this 16th day of March 1869

is granted him to be joined in the probate of
